

NILES NORTH FINE ARTS PARENTS & PATRONS, LTD 2017 SUMMER GRANT INFORMATION

The Niles North Fine Arts Parents & Patrons grants are awarded to help fine arts students enhance their skills and encourage their continued involvement in all the Fine Arts.

To better assess applicants' artistic commitment, inspiration, and willingness to share the learning experience, the student is required to include the following:

- A brief arts resume,
- An essay written by the student on how you have been inspired by another artist or work,
- A proposal written by the student for how you would share this learning experience with fellow students,
- And an endorsement/recommendation by a fine arts teacher.

Please carefully review all the grant requirements and specifics before thoughtfully completing the attached application. The student need not be accepted yet or registered for a summer workshop/class/camp/program to apply for this grant. However, final awards are contingent on your registration/acceptance.

The 2017 NNFAPP Summer Grants will be reviewed and awarded as follows:

- Only **freshman, sophomores, and juniors** enrolled in fine arts or dance classes, or a Niles North extra-curricular ensemble in 2016-17 are eligible.
- Designate the program area (art, band, choir, dance, orchestra, or theatre) for application, and this program area must correspond to the supported activity.
- Grant funds may be awarded for master classes, creative workshops, art classes, private lessons, camps, participation in ensembles or online fine arts courses.
- Grant funds will **not** be awarded to purchase or rent supplies and instruments or school sanctioned trips. Some educational materials such as an arts-specific periodical or magazine or educational instructional books may be eligible and is subject to evaluation by the fine arts teacher.
- Supported activities must be completed before the start of the 2017-18 school year.
- Grant awards will be paid directly to the sponsoring person or organization. Parent(s)/guardian(s) may be reimbursed upon valid documented proof (photocopy of credit card receipt, cancelled check) for the class, workshop, lessons, etc. that have been paid for.
- The application must be received by Marie Walton, Niles North Fine Arts Administrative Assistant, Room 1527, by Tuesday, April 18, 2017. Applications will be reviewed by a Fine Arts Parents and Patrons Grant Review Committee.
- Reviewers will evaluate complete and eligible applications based on the value and merits of the program or activity, and the submitted evidence of your commitment and inspiration, as well as your plan to share the experience with your fellow students. (This is not a financial need based grant.)
- Total number of grants awarded and grant amounts is at the sole discretion of the NNFAPP Board. Decisions are based on available organization funds, number of applications received and program area distribution. Individual grants awarded will vary upon review of the applications and ranking. A rubric has been included for the student.
- Membership in Niles North Fine Arts Parents & Patrons is not required, but strongly recommended.
